This I command you: love one another."

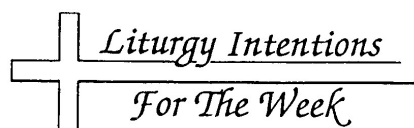

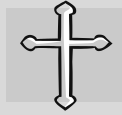
